

FMLA, Leaves of Absence (LOA) & Disability Process and Administration Changes

To: All U.S. based Legacy DIRECTV employees

Beginning Jan. 1, 2017, employees will align under new processes for requesting FMLA, Leaves of Absence and Disability.

Here is what you need to know:

- Any approved open requests on Dec. 31, 2016, will be managed through completion with our current administrator, The Hartford.
- On Jan. 1, our Corporate Attendance Leave Management team will administer the FMLA and LOA process.

o FMLA

- Eligibility will move from a rolling year to a fixed-calendar year.
- Supervisors will submit requests via the Online FMLA Request Form.

o LOA

- You will be eligible for Leaves under your applicable AT&T Leave of Absence Policy.
